**Good Evening !**  
**Ladies and Gentlemen !**

On the occasion of our 39<sup>th</sup> Annual Day Celebration, I extend a warm and hearty welcome to the Hon'ble Chief Guest of the programme Commodore Atul Khanna, Chairman VMC, KV, Karanja and Madam Dr. Archana Khanna.; members of the Vidyalaya Management Committee; members of the Parent Teacher association; all our special invitees; parents, staff members & their families and all others who are here with us this evening !

At this auspicious hour, I feel privileged to present you a birds eye view of the achievements that Kendriya Vidyalaya, Naval Station Karanja attained in the Academic session 2009-10.

## **1. SCHOOL**

Kendriya Vidyalaya Naval Station Karanja is a Defence Sector school sponsored by Naval Station, Karanja and caters to the needs of the children of all the Central Government Employees. The facility of admission has been extended to the students of State Government Employees wards and floating population also. The school came into existence in the year 1970 and became a full-fledged four section school upto class X and at +2 level two sections of Class in Science Stream and in the one section Commerce Stream .

## **2. STAFF**

As on the Last day of Academic Session 2009-10 i.e. 31/03/2010, the school is accommodating **1551** students with **63** staff members. This year even though 08 teachers were transferred out, but with the incessant efforts of the Ex-Chairman, VMC is fortunate to take 12 new teachers into its strength as TGT, PRTs and Computer instructors on Ad-hoc Basis.

Mr. V. Paradhasardhi, PGT English joined on deputation in Mongolia in the month of December 2009.

## **3. ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE**

- In the CBSE Examination in the academic year 2008-09, the overall pass percentage of class X is 93.13% and class XII Science is 100% and Commerce Stream is 93.75%

Kum. Pooja Gupta stood first in Class XII Science stream with 95%. Kum. Richa Bhardwaj with 82% stood first in class XII Commerce stream. Mast. Suraj Unnikrishnan with 92% stood first in class X.

The teachers teaching board classes X and XII took extra efforts by taking remedial and extra classes during morning assembly period, sometimes after the School hours and during Autumn and Winter-break holidays. The respective teachers made child-wise and subject-wise analysis. The concepts of particular topics were clearly dealt with. Model questions on all topics at easy and difficult levels were prepared and practiced thoroughly.

- In the home examinations during the Academic year 2009-10, the results are excellent, pass percentage of school is 99.9% in which Primary Section produced 100% pass result.

- More than 20 students took admission in professional courses(Engineering, Medicine through AIEEE and MH-CET), information available on school website, [www.kvkaranja.org](http://www.kvkaranja.org)
- School level Science Exhibition was held on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2009 ,inaugurated by SOK Naval Station Karanja and Chairman VMC.The Vidyalaya participated in Science Exhibition held at KV IIT Powai organized by KVS (RO), Mumbai in Sept 09.The Vidyalaya students participated and brought laurels in various competitions like AISMTA, 12<sup>th</sup> NATIONAL SCIENCE OLYMPIAD, 3<sup>rd</sup> INTERNATIONAL MATH OLYMPIAD,INTERNATIONAL OLYMPIAD OF SCIENCE , UNIFIED CYBER OLYMPIAD in which Aayushi Pathak from class VI ranked 601 at All India level.
- School level paintings and Poster Competitions under the National campaign on Energy Conservation 2009 for the students of Class IV & V were organized and Two best paintings were sent to National Level Paintings and Poster Competition 2009.

In 6<sup>th</sup> All India KV Child Art Exhibition 2009 (Drawing & Painting Competition) sponsored by KV ONGC, Project Rajamundry. Mast. Durga Jyoti Bandopadhyay of class X B got Gold Medal.

Cluster Level Social Science Exhibition at KV, AFS, Thane was held in which two Students got First Position in Drawing & Painting Competition and were selected for Regional Level.

On the Occasion of Children's Day 2009 and Earth Day 2010 School Level Drawing Competition were organized.

- In order to inculcate the leadership quality, sense of discipline, moral values house-wise Co-curricular activities were conducted. During the session 23 competitions at Secondary Level and 19 competitions at Primary level were conducted. Besides, the school celebrated Independence Day, Republic Day, World Health Day, World Earth Day, World Population Day, World Water Day, Anti Leprosy Day, World Aids Day, Martyrs' Day, Childrens' Day, Teachers' Day, Thinking Day, National Science Day, National Education Day, National Consumer Awareness Day, Youth Day, KVS Foundation Day, Grand Parents' Day, Vigilance Week, Hindi Pakhawada etc.
- Common Minimum Programme in the Primary Education was fully implemented with an expenditure of Rs. 5000/- per month to generate Teaching-Learning Material for conducting Indoor and Outdoor activities. The teaching aids OHP, LCD Projector, Colour TV, Computer, Interactive Board and Digital Printer were made available for regular use. And every Saturday was observed as the activity day. A teacher was appointed to take – up Spoken English classes in the Primary Section. These classes helped the pupils to improve their listening, speaking, writing and reading skills in English.

#### 4. SPORTS AND GAMES

All the students were given opportunity to participate in different sports at Vidyalaya level. Total 155 students, 110 Boys and 45 Girls, participated in Sports activities under 03 groups, Under 14, 16, 19 Boys and Girls separately in various events like Volley-Ball, Basket Ball, Badminton, Kho-Kho, Swimming, Table Tennis, Shooting and Athletics etc. either at Cluster Level, Regional Level or National Levels.

- Mast. Atul Patil, Mast. Vishnu P. and Mast. Vijay Gopal got Gold Medal in Cricket Under-19.
- Mast. Ankur got Silver Medal in Kho-Kho.

The Sports Day was celebrated on 23/01/2010 in a grand manner. In Sports and Games RAMAN House bagged the Winners' Trophy and ASHOKA House took Runner Up Trophy.

### **5. SCOUTS AND GUIDES**

Various activities and programmes for Scouts & Guides conducted during Academic Year 2009-10 are as follows :

- Tritiya Sopan Testing Camp was held for Scouts at KV NRC, Nasik Road and for Guides at KV BEG, Pune from 10/04/2009 to 12/04/2009. In this camp 09 Scouts and 05 Guides participated and Passed Tritiya Sopan Test.
- 03 Scouts and 01 Guides attended **Rajya Puraskar** Testing Camp in Chennai and received Rajya Puraskar.
- Cubs & Bulbul Utsav was held on Children's Day 14/11/2009 at KV no. 3 Colaba in which our Vidyalaya bagged most of the prizes.
- Communal Harmony week was observed from 19/11/2009 to 25/11/2009 by KV Karanja Scouts & Guides Unit.
- Thinking Day was celebrated on the Occasion of Lord Baden Powell's Birth Anniversary on 22/02/2010.
- Trekking Programme was also conducted for all the Cubs & Bulbuls, Scouts & Guides who participated in the trekking at Vollana Tower on 02/03/2010.
- Besides this Scouts & Guides Activities are conducted on every Thursday of the week.

### **6. EDUCATIONAL TOURS**

As part of educational tour .

- 100 Students participated in Special National Adventure Programme in Pachmarhi in December '2009.
- Students from Primary as well as Secondary section were taken to Essel World, Water Kingdom and Tikku -ni- Wadi on 18th and 19th of February 2010.

### **7. INFRASTRUCTURE**

- At present the school has 75 Computers. The Computers in the Staff Room, Primary Computer Lab, Junior Computer Lab, Secondary Computer Lab, Library, Office and Principal's Office are equipped with Broad Band Internet Facility.
- All the Students have been enrolled and working in Thinkquest.com, an Online Study Environment. Class XI & XII Computer Sc. students worked in Online Programming Project under the Project Leader Mr. Dinesh Patel, PGT Computer Science.

- Library has got 14,427 books and with subscription of some 30 Magazines on various fields.
- White Boards are fixed in Primary Classes , Secondary Classes and Secondary Computer Lab.
- One fountain is built in front of the Vidyalaya Gate. A pond is also built for growing Lotus.
- Tiles have been fixed in the Vidyalaya.
- Digital Duplicator worth Rs. 01 lakh was purchased on 28<sup>th</sup> October ‘2009 for exam dept.
- As for SUPW Dept., besides Training them Craft Materials, Files, Paper Bags, Knowledge about First-Aids, Balance-Diet, Food & Nutrition is also imparted to them.
- An Exhibition of Art, Craft & SUPW on 23/01/2010 was arranged.

## **8. EXHIBITIONS AND COUNSELLING**

- Regional Level Social Science Exhibition was held at KV no. 2 Colaba. Two exhibits were selected for National Level Social Science Exhibition.
- Dilesh Kumar and Sharad Bhosle of Class XI Sc. got 1<sup>st</sup> position in Jugalbandi and got selected for the National Level Social Science Exhibition 2009.
- Counselling was done from time to time regarding Teen age Problems, Stress Management, Career etc.

## **9. VIDYALAYA MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**

The Vidyalaya has an effective and efficient Vidyalaya Management Committee. This year the Committee met in the school on 07/08/2009, 08/12/2009 and 10/02/2010 in order to discuss various things for the smooth running and functioning of the school under the Chairmanship Senior Officer, Naval Station Karanja. He was ably assisted by Commander Manmeet Singh, the Chairman’s Nominee.
